Due to the importance and imminence of Year End Transition, the YET Conference Call was combined with the main L1 Conference Call this week.

Year End Transition was kicked off at midnight on Sunday. The process is currently on step 4 of 19 steps, and is expected to be on step 4 for the remainder of this week. There have been no problems so far. Members of the team are monitoring every hour, on the hour, and will continue to do so until the process has completed.

Last week a few districts expressed concern about needing to run report cards before YET completes. SDTest is a complete copy of Production just before it was taken offline, so if you need to run report cards before YET has completed you should be able to do so by entering final marks in SD Test. We contacted all districts last week with a workaround whereby we will extract marks from SDTest and load them into Credit Details in Production after YET has completed. This information is also on the ISW under L1 Support Resources > Technical Update Bulletins and includes the process for advising the Service Desk that you would like to participate in this service.

The Service Desk worked on the weekend to load the June provincial exam marks into Production before YET started, and as a result, these marks were copied to SD Test.
