

<p>Yet code and testing</p>	<p>Code was due last Friday but has not arrived yet. Revised aal ETA is this Friday and we are gearing up for the first test which is to ensure that the new code functionality works. We're hoping to run on a small database this weekend, at this point this is tentative. We don't expect the code until Friday morning. Will update you on next Tuesday call.</p>
<p>Next year homeroom</p>	<p>SD75 enquired if it is still necessary to put incoming students in next year home rooms for to make sure they come when YET is run? In the past if you didn't put them in homerooms you lost them.</p> <p><u>Response:</u> That's no longer the case.</p> <p>SD39 asked if there are any exceptions to the rule – i.e. is there a simple statement that can be made to cover all scenarios: pre-transitioned, cross-enrolled, and pre-admitted?</p> <p><u>Response:</u> All you need is next year school and next year grade, regardless of the scenario. You don't need home room or course. However, it needs to be stated that this is how it worked last year in v11.1. We are on v12.0 now and we will be testing again to make sure it's still the case.</p>

<p>End dating program assignments on withdrawal</p>	<p>SD43 submitted an email asking for an update on the end dating of program assignments on withdrawal.</p> <p><u>Response:</u> Dorothy Ward advised that she would forward their email to Norm Walker to find out what is happening with that.</p> <p>Norm advised that the OSWG is looking at what the standard should be in terms of end dating programs.</p> <p>SD43 also reiterated that the GDE only picks up current year program assignments.</p> <p><u>Response:</u> We will provide an update on this next week.</p>
<p>Health Checks</p>	<p>These will start at the end of May. We are preparing a summary doc re all the info we are checking for and will post it to the ISW when it's finalized.</p> <p>We will do a preliminary run as soon as the code is received and will report status of data health thereafter. If problems are identified, the YET contact or L1 will be advised of anything that needs to be corrected.</p>
<p>Pre-Transition Verification Report</p>	<p>In response to the question from SD75 last week re whether courses with no final reporting periods need to be cleaned up for YET to run: These will not cause any problems with YET but it is still recommended, in terms of data quality, that these be cleaned up. It's the safest thing to do to be absolutely sure they will not cause any post YET problems.</p>
<p>Withdrawn students with the next school field still populated</p>	<p>In response to this item raised last week, we determined that there are numerous warnings and error messages to help users. If people are not seeing the error messages they should submit a HEAT ticket.</p>
