

Yet code and testing	Code was received last Friday. We are still looking at the release notes to understand what's new and what's changed. We will be setting up our test cases based on that analysis. There is also a lengthy list of pre-releases identified which will need to be implemented first. We are currently looking at the potential impact of these as well.
End dating program assignments on withdrawal	Aal has made some changes in the way that end dating programs works in YET. We haven't done any analysis yet on these changes as the code has just been received. In response to discussions on last week and this week's calls regarding the GDE and end dated programs, the following update was provided: We will be modifying the GDE Extract to pick up all open program assignments even if they were created in previous years. However, we have not put this in our development cycle yet so there are no further details at this time.

It will also be available on the Year End Transition 2010 page on the Important YET Resources table. We have removed the information around the manual .csv process which was created specifically for the DL Achievement process so that an Effective Date could be re-entered. SADE does not use the Effective Date, so there is no need to use this process anymore.
