

<p><b>YET code and testing</b></p>	<p>We have finally been able to complete small database test, which took just over 19 hours. The testing team is completing the after-testing and will be preparing a summary that will be available on the ISW. For those who sent in testing requests via HEAT, the summary will include HEAT ticket numbers for referencing.</p> <p>The next step will be two full database tests, the first to test the application functionality and the second for bug fixes and Dry Run to tighten up the timing. We hope to start the first one next week. We are doing our absolute best to get information to everyone before the end of the school year, and hope to have more details to give you after the first full test.</p>
<p><b>District Data Verifications (Health Checks)</b></p>	<p>The health checks flag anything in your data that will either stop YET, or cause some undesirable results for districts post-YET. <p><b>Standardized Test Records</b></p>	<p>A question was submitted from SD68:</p> <p>“In 2008 school year when next year courses were scheduled, Standardized Test Records for 2009-10 provincially examinable courses used the 2008-09 student grade level, rather than the 2009-10 grade level. A DQR was created to correct this in the 2009 school year. Will that be the case again for 2010?”</p> <p>The answer is Yes, a DQR will be created for this.</p>
